



**Minutes of Meeting Gunness Parish Council 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 Sheet 2.**

**Playing Field Matters Min 150/2011**

Quote from KI Contractors to install safety fencing to the entrance from the 10ft. rear Station Road following problems with vandalism to the last two gate closure systems. The quote also included remedial work to the surfacing under the seat & repair to the round-a-bout for the sum of £730.50. Cllr Oldfield brought to the meeting quote from AGN Fencing to install a standard gate closing spring at a cost of £80 +VAT.

**Resolved** : That the standard spring quote AGN be accepted  
KI Contractors to be asked for a revised quote to  
carry out remedial work to the seat surfacing & round-a-bout.

**Removal of tree** : Cllr Craddock proposed that the tree which was a self set be removed as it was causing a nuisance, growing through & damaging the boundary fence. Cllr Oldfield did not agree with this proposal and after discussion it was :

**Resolved** : That all Members visit the site before the next meeting following which a decision will be made.

**Pitch fixture lists** : Desert Rat team have changed their name to 7 Lakes, to reflect new sponsors, Cllr Oldfield now in possession of full fixture list for the season. Cllr Gray stated that now only two teams were using the pitches no problems over matches should present itself.

**Dog Waste Bins Gunness Min 151/2011**

Following our request to install extra dog waste bins in Gunness NLC have sent quotes to install an additional two bins and will service them FOC as both can be accessed directly from the adopted highway. Bin for entrance to PROW OVS suggested fixing to Campbells Farm Ave. street name post £90.88 : Same price for installing bin on PROW rear of boundary fence playing field, do not recommend the bin on the field car park be removed but left in situ as it is very well used amenity, if do want removed and relocated to PROW £18.32. Much discussion took place on this item especially the site at Campbell's Farm, Cllr Armitage suggested siting down the PROW adjacent to the new copped area, Clerk stated there could be a problem with land ownership as we could require permission to erect at this location it was thought that if sited on the edge of the lane this was classed as public land. Cllr Oldfield proposed that the car park bin be relocated as persons could use the litter bin to deposit dog waste. Cllr Gosling proposed that two new bins be purchased and on a vote being taken **Resolved** : That before final decision made NLC be asked if they would service bin if placed down PROW.

**Matters relating to L/M Estate Min 152/2011**

Cllr Devine thanked the Council for the £500 donation towards the LMRA fun day and whilst she was disappointed at the attendance those that took part enjoyed the day. The event cost £511.36. They also had a problem with dog waste bins on the green belt to the rear of the estate as they had been moved from their previous position in the tree line and place adjacent to residents fencing. Letter to be sent to North Lincolnshire Homes responsible for this area were to be asked to relocate to their original position.

**Matters Relating to Berkeley Estate Min 153/2011**

Street lights out reported & fixed. New owners had moved into the house on corner of Fillingham Crescent and the garden had now been tidied.

**Councillor's Reports Min 155/2011**

Cllr Armitage : Any progress with installing "Deer warning signs" Neap House Road  
Clerk stated this had been passed to another dept. of NLC would chase up

Cllr McIlvaney : Did Police get copy of agenda & minutes as there had been several thefts from sheds & our buildings on Doncaster Road no action appears to be taken.

Cllr Oldfield stated that Police no longer attend Parish Council meetings all problems dealt with at NAT meetings, he was not aware that any of these thefts had been reported to police. Clerk informed Cllr McIlvaney that minutes etc were delivered to P C Kirkby at the same time as Members.

Cllr Craddock : Amount of dog fouling on playing field ; whilst a leaflet drop wold make residents aware many from outside the village used the field. Cllr Gosling stated that persons not picking up waste would not take any notice of a leaflets : Cllr Porter was in favour of dogs only allowed if kept on leads, it was agreed this would be difficult to police. Cllr Gosling ; an alternative was to ban dogs from the field but this would not be fair on responsible dog owners. Ongoing.

Cllr Etchell : Telephone cable theft was causing much concern for BT right across the region present problems at Keadby West Butterwick still not connected : as far afield as Bawtry ; Wath on Dearne ; Barnby Dun all ongoing at present.

Cllr Oldfield : Spoken to Mr Standish re the goal mouth reseed at Gunness not carried out : Mr Long had agreed to mark out the caged area FOC . He was of the opinion that either the goal areas on L/M were reseeded or we have a rebate on the SLA agreement
