**Playing Field Matters Min 128/2014**

Adhoc Pitch Bookings : Cllr Gray : Rubbish left on touchline & field following matches, teams just coming, paying as no other pitches available not clearing up after matches. Request notice be placed in changing rooms re leaving them swept & tidy ; litter removed from field. Cllr D.West had looked round the field & inside the port-a-cabin ; left in disgusting state ; not been swept out mud & grass all over floor ; away team changing room had stud hole in the walls, obviously been kicked. Cllr Craddock : The Council had only agreed to one adhoc game the rest were all down to Cllr Oldfield, first match players had left the field tidy. Cllr Gray : Cllr Oldfield should accept responsibility for state of field & unit for these adhoc matches. Mr Furnell, in his letter had informed us that the goal net supports had been damaged, he had swapped these for the supports on the junior posts. Following further discussion on pitch letting out of season Cllr Craddock stated that the extra cash this had generated would need to be spent on remedial work and proposed that no extra bookings be taken after the end of season next year, on a vote being taken majority in favour

**Matters Relating to Lodge Moors Estate Min 129/2014**

Cllr Devine requested purchase of 2 seats for siting on the estate Cllr Oldfield had obtained quote from Broxap £933.60. which included VAT & £108 delivery charge only.

Cllr Devine : Site grassed area rear of cage ; Clerk advised this is not our land, in her opinion permission would need to be sought from NLC before ordering/erecting seats. Cllr D.West proposed that the provision of seats be approved in principle once NLC have agreed the site.

Cllr McIlvaney concerned that the area is not fenced and is fronted by a busy road ; Cllr Oldfield informed was negotiating with NLC to have some small fencing being removed from West Street area to be reused on Kensington Road.

Cllr Devine : All quiet at moment : Report death of Mr Walmsley. Cllr Craddock : State of footpath down A18 Doncaster Road ; Incident resident on mobility scooter had tipped over paths not wide enough to accommodate scooters. Write to NLC Highways to consider remedial work

Cllr P.West : State of PROW down towards sewage works exceptionally badly rutted hedges overhanging : Contact Severn Trent requesting remedial work.

Cllr Porter : Many complaints re noise from Jolly Sailor especially car park. Had spoken to but they had insisted that it was not their responsibility outside the premises, Glasses from the Jolly had been taken off premises and thrown in Mill Lane ;Cllr Oldfield stated he had also spoken to Land lady and received the same reply ; had requested PCSO's to visit.

Cllr Oldfield : Lamp posts being renewed along Station Road

Consider holding meetings on Lodge Moors estate every three to four months.

Clerk stated that request had been made to Lodge Moors Community Asstn. on previous occasion room not available on Thursday nights. Cllr Devine suggested meetings be held in the smaller Board Room which should be big enough as very rarely full quota of 14 Members present.

Further suggestion that meeting be held on night other than Thursdays ; would be considered.
