Report from North Lincolnshire Ward Councillor Min 150/2016

Cllr Oldfield ; Complaint from resident re the Seat recently installed on Kelsey Avenue, users looked straight into he lounge window needs resiting. Cllr Oldfield had spoken to the residents in question who had agreed to monitor the intrusion for a short while. NLC had placed the seat 1ft from the footpath but the agreed site was 4ft. If causing nuisance would have to be moved. Ongoing. Proposed footpath from A18 to Warming Way NLC had confirmed in writing to Cllr Shaw work would be carried out end of March 2017. Amount of fly tipping on the new cycleway off Station Road Gunness beyond the bollards queried how this had been placed in this location, Cllr Gosling stated there was an entrance off the A18 Doncaster Road. PCSO Bekky Jennings had returned to this area, reported to him suspicious activities in the village, break in on Station Road stole car keys but car was not on site. Defibrillator unit had been installed on the side of St. Barnabas Church, training on it's usage was available. NLC have restructured the Highways & Neighbourhood Services Departments.

2016/1444 ; Burnell ; 5 OVS ; replace flat roof with pitched roof No Objection.

Playing Field Matters Min 154/2016

Letter from Ironstones F.C advising that there were not enough players to run two senior teams for 2016/17 season just 1 team in division 1. The £1000 sponsorship, £500 between the then two senior teams £500 for the four junior teams would now equate to £750, cheque enclosed for £490 being upfront pitch fees for 8 matches & the £250 allocated to the senior teams. Clerk informed Members that last year there were similar circumstances, only 1 senior, team pitch fees had been paid for two teams meaning they were in credit for 7 matches this season. (£30 short for fixtures this year). Cllr Gosling ; A payment to Ironstone FC of £1000 had been approved at an earlier meeting which stood. Proposed the cheque for £490 be returned to the club, the £1000 donation be kept. Agreed. TVES quote to renew faulty timer switch Gunness Field £66 + VAT Accept ; Clerk to action.

Matters Relating to Lodge Moors Estate Min 155/2016

NLC ; Copy of Castleton Road Play area Inspection Report ; Only matter Iron Inspection Cover in footpath cracked, could be BT, potential trip hazard. Reported to ONGO. Noted.

Letter from ONGO ,in answer to our correspondence sent following September meeting, on Parish Council presence at HALMA public meetings. Circulated to Members with agenda. Cllr Gosling ; not aware of contents of letter sent to ONGO as Cllr Gray who had chaired the August meeting had approved correspondence. This matter would be discussed at the next meeting, requested a copy of letter sent to ONGO be included to all Members with the agenda.

Matters Relating to Hilton Avenue Estate Min 156/2016

Two items ; Garages & Goal Posts. Clerk reported telephone conversation with Mr Clark ONGO re the garages. Only garages in their ownership is off Hilton Avenue rear of Westburn Way which are kept in good condition it would be difficult to find who owned all the others on the estate. Cllr Shaw/Gosling confirmed that these garages were OK. Of the other four sets many were in a dilapidated & hazardous condition, were a safety risk. Cllr Walker ; if in such a dangerous condition NLC should take action. Cllr Gosling ; should be allocated to the flats & other properties. Mrs McGoverne had sent Cllr Shaw details of local letting agents who could own some of the properties. Cllr Oldfield agreed to bring this to NLC attention.

Goal posts ; Cllr Oldfield had spoken to Mr Wardman, NLC, who had suggested that Wicksteed Leisure should be asked if they removed them when they installed the MUGA. Cllr Devine ; had seen them loaded onto a NLC lorry as reported at the August meeting. Cllr Oldfield proposed we explore funding a small goal post, Cllr P.McIlvaney & netball hoop. To be discussed further at next meeting Agreed.

Cllr Shaw reported lots of broken glass on land rear of B&Q ; Cllr Oldfield to visit store & complain.

Councillor's Reports Min 157/2016

Cllr Armitage : Incident on Neap House Road ; m/cyclist had spoken to a small child asking him to go for a ride on his bike, this had been reported to the police but to date no Officer had attended. Cllr Gosling ; this needed reporting at NAT Meeting.

Cllr Oldfield ; Mr Dent had approached him with a request to clean out the dyke side of playing field along the PROW. He proposed we obtain price for this work. Clerk advised this is not our land but in the ownership of Mr Dent. Cllr Gosling asked if we had any obligation as a riparian owner as the playing field drained into the dyke. Clerk asked to investigate.
