Report from North Lincolnshire Ward Councillor Min 39/2018

Cllr Oldfield ; Trying to find solution to a row of conifers on the Northern Boundary of Hilton Avenue, originally planted by Grant Lyon to screen their boundary with a ten year control order that has long since expired. Land is not registered with Land Registry ownership not known. NLC have raised Council Tax for the coming financial year to 4.99% of which 3% is ring fenced for Social Services. Member of public had questioned no finance for improvements at Berkeley Circle. Burringham By-pass had been put on hold. Introducing a scheme, Community Speed Watch, which would train persons to use speed guns in some areas. Had been informed that Gunness had not put an expression of interest in for the North Lincs in Bloom Project.

Planning Matters Min 41/2018

2017/1868 : Tesco Stores ; to remove condition to allow additional franchises to operate from . FPP Granted

Clerk stated she had circulated this for information as Members were not aware that this permission included facilities for storage of oils, fuels & Chemicals. Cllr Etchell, Planning Committee Chairman stated that in his opinion once FPP had been granted there was little we could do.

Discuss & Approve SLA Agreements for this Financial Year Min 42/2018

NLC have sent schedule of charges for the coming financial year advising that charges have been increased in some cases a rather large increase.

After discussion Resolved that on Gunness Field increase the gang mowing from 16 cuts to 24 @ £72 per cut

This to include the whole field including the senior pitch. Total now £4191.00

++++Cllr Walker ; could get quote from alternative contractor due to the large increase, this was not seconded.

Resolved ; That NLC be informed of changes ; Agree to accept SLA's as above.

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Playing Field Matters Min 43/2018

Streetscape have carried out a site visit to seek remedy for the complaints re the zip wire. Min 26& 33/2018 refers. They have indicated that despite the non payment of their account re Kensington Road they will continue to support & monitor this facility as a gesture of goodwill. Cllr Oldfield proposed we explore provision of access ramp. Cllr Gray reported that again the lights had been left on on Thursday night after football training, this is the third month it has been brought to a Council Meeting & no action has been taken by the football teams, they are taking advantage of the fact that this facility is allowed at no charge to the clubs. Cllr Walker queried why the play equipment lights were needed as the MUGA had it's own lights & proposed we put another padlock on. Cllr Oldfield proposed letter to be sent to Mr Furnell advising that this situation could result in any future funding requests for the teams being refused. Cllr Guilfoyle proposed that if there was no improvement following letter to Mr Furnell then we consider changing the lock with no keys issued to any person. Agreed.

Pest Control had captured three moles on his last two visits.

Matters Relating to L/Moors Estate Min 44/2018

Cllr McIlvaney ; Litter bins still no action on bin rear M/S or near seat . Request that a Notice Board be installed on both estates to keep residents informed of Parish matters. Cllr Oldfield proposed they be located at the corner of Castleton Road or to the rear of the bus stop. Cllr Gosling ; the community centre would be a safe place to prevent any vandalism ; Cllr McIlvaney no room in present notice board at the Centre . Cllr Gray was asked if Mr P Gray, who made the new notice board in Gunness, would quote for this would ask but can't commit. Heated discussion took place resulting in Cllr Gray telling Cllr Oldfield to sort it out.

Matters Relating to Hilton Avenue Estate Min 45/2018

Cllr Oldfield was still trying to get the pot holes filled in many parts of the estate ; Bin still not returned near the seat. Cllr Gosling : While it was Cllr Shaw who was asking for a notice board for the estate in his opinion there were no suitable locations that covered the whole Estate for residents to take full advantage

Humber Emergency Plan Update Min 46/2018

Cllr Etchell ; Not much response to plan Emailed to Members ; Clerk had sent information on contact details. Required copy of Electoral Roll to place in emergency box. Ongoing.

Review of Standing Orders Min 47/2018

No progress ; Cllr Oldfield had not yet arranged a meeting to discuss.

Supply Council Owned I.T Equipment Min 48/2018

Cllr Gosling had asked for this item on the agenda. Clerk advised that following the event held by ERNLLCA to discuss the new E.U.Data Protection Law (GDPR) coming into effect in May 2018 it will be mandatory that no personal computers can be used for Council business, each Parish Council must have own equipment etc. Required 1 Laptop 1 printer & access to the internet & more training for the Clerk. Cllr Gosling asked the Clerk if she would be willing to liaise with Cllr Etchell who had a wide knowledge of I.T. Agreed.

Councillors Reports Min 49/2018

Cllr Oldfield : Complaint from Mr McWeeney that the entrance to the field off the car park was not wide enough for his mother in law's wheelchair. Cllr Oldfield proposed we remove the fence that was places to prevent motorcycle access, this was not seconded. Cllr Gray suggested that they use the entrance off Station Road which has easy access.
